



Be a Museum Curator for a day

Offered as a full-day session



Activity

Each session will be led by a representative from the Helena Thompson Museum.

Using real items (some replicas) from the Museum Archive, find out what a Museum Curator does and step into their shoes for a day. Find out where to find artefacts and specimens.

Join the team at The Helena Thompson Museum.

- Choose a topic, select your items for your display and find out more information about them.
- How old is the object?
- Where or how was it used?
- Is the object of local interest?
- Why do you need to wear 'white gloves' when handling some artefacts?
- Choose an item to show and talk about to the other groups.
- Plan and create an Exhibition where you can display the artefacts.

Each child will receive a Certificate.
