## Activity

Each of the activity sessions will be led by a representative from the Helena Thompson Museum.

In this event, we take a look at the age of the Victorians and what was happening in the world at that time, as well as in our home town.

- What was family life like?
- Who were the famous Victorians and inventors?
- What work did people do?
- What items would have been used in the Victorian home?
- What was it like to be a maid in "the big house"?

The above topic will be explored using museum artefacts, (some of which may be replicas), craft, games such as a board game, snap, 'pairing cards', treasure hunt and quizzes.

During the day, each visiting group will be split into four to take part in activities; can we therefore please have at least four members of staff to accompany the group? Thank you.
